### Still Family History, by Samuel C. Still, III

The Still Family has a long and illustrious history in Burlington County. Famous descendants include Medford's Dr. James Still, William Still, underground railroad founder and their brother Still, who bought his way out of slavery. Many other members of this large family were high achievers, down to the present generation. Join Sam Still for an illustrated talk about his relatives and their fascinating lives.

Samuel C. Still III is the 3rd Great Grandson of Levin and Charity Still. Samuel began telling his family's story at 13 years old in local elementary schools in southern New Jersey where he grew up. As a child, his father Samuel Still Jr. would take him on long hikes in and around the Pine Barrens of New Jersey where Levin and Charity raised their 18 children. They would visit the old family homestead in Shamong Township and other places that were part of the family history. They would attend the numerous family reunions that were held every year in different towns in New Jersey always taking notes on the stories from other family members. Samuel is the chairman of the Dr. James Still Historic Site and Education Center in Medford.
